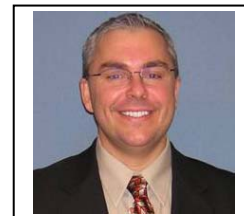

Each month during the listening posts, citizens also can learn and discuss a hot and emerging issue that Johnson County is facing. In June, the Hot Topics Discussion will be on Rural Economic Development Conditional Use Permits. Currently Johnson County allows rural residents to own and operate businesses in their homes or on their farms, but many require a permit. Learn about those requirements and about potential changes that may occur to encourage and allow more conditional use permits, especially for ag-related businesses.
