Neuzil to Hold March Government and You Listening Posts

In March, the Hot Topics Discussion will be on the Road Performance Standards Ordinance. Currently, Johnson County has heavy restrictions of rural development on zoned residential land based on the amount of vehicles that travel per day on chip seal road surfaces. Recently, Johnson County officials discussed the possibility of loosening those restrictions or rescinding the ordinance altogether.
