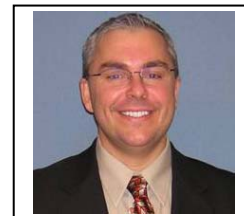

Neuzil to Hold January Government and You Listening Posts *Hot Topics Discussion: Impacts of State & Federal Budget Cuts*
